## **Safety During an Incident**

- Try to be in a room with an exit—a window or a door leading outside. Avoid the kitchen, bathroom, or places near weapons
- Try to get to a room that has a phone, or have a cell phone handy if possible
- Use code word so family, neighbors, or friends can call 911 for you if needed
- Keep your purse and car keys in the same place so they can be found quickly
- Tell trusted neighbors to watch for signs of violence so they can call the police
- If in immediate danger, call 911 if you are able

## **Safety When Preparing to Leave**

- Plan where you will go if you leave your house and how you will get there. Consider trusted family, friends, or organizations in your community
- Develop a code word with your family, or friends so they can call 911 or someone safe for you if needed
- Become familiar with the surroundings in your area
- Open a savings account in a new bank in your name only (if possible)
- Set aside (with friends or at home):
  - An extra set of keys
  - Money
  - Extra clothing
  - Medications
  - Important numbers
  - Critical documents (ID, birth certificate, social security card)
  - Any important legal paperwork (marriage certificate, visas, etc.)
- Consider getting a pre-paid, private cell phone that your unsafe person does not know about
